
Our Programs & Age Groups

Little Cherries



This room is dedicated for our youngest ProducKIDvity members ranging from 6 months to 1 year in age. This room is fully equipped for everything a baby needs and is right next door to our nursing room making it easy for Mom to pop-in for feedings if needed.

Curriculum-Based Learning

Our educational programs and goals align closely with the BC Early Learning Framework. Parents receive frequent updates via the HiMama app detailing their child's learning experiences and illustrating how these activities contribute to their social, emotional, and physical development. Additionally, we utilize Ages and Stages Questionnaires to monitor your child's developmental progress based on their age.

Furthermore, our classrooms are organized according to age and developmental stage. This means that your one-year-old will be grouped with peers who are also at a similar developmental stage, ensuring that they receive tailored support and guidance appropriate for their needs.
